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Inmate Job and Resource Fair Scheduled at Metro Facility

Event helps prepare individuals for success after release

Nashville, Tenn. - In partnership with Davidson County Sheriff's Department (DCSO), CoreCivic's Metro Davidson County Detention Facility is hosting a reentry resource fair on Wednesday, January 31 starting at 11 am for incarcerated individuals who are preparing for their release and reentry into the free world.

The resource fair will include outside vendors to assist individuals in the following areas for reentry: mental health services, transitional housing assistance, treatment services and halfway houses, job placement and employers, and social services. Additional vendors will provide assistance for female offenders including services for incarcerated parents, domestic violence counselors and addiction treatment (The Next Door.)
